Rezept

Bauernschmarren am Dachstein
Auf 1.440 Meter Seehöhe - fast auf halber Höhe des Dachstein - steht das Wirtshaus Dachstein wie auf einem natürlichen Balkon über der Ramsau. Eine besondere Spezialität des Hauses ist der Bauernschmarren.

Die Zutaten (für vier Personen):

1/2 l Milch

1/4 l Mineralwasser

3 Eier

Salz, Pfeffer

1 Zwiebel

Kräuter: Schnittlauch, Jungzwiebel, Petersilie, Gundrebe, junger Kren – etwa 1 handvoll

1 EL Gammelschmalz

200 g Speck

50 dag Dinkelmehl

Die Zubereitung:

Zuerst Speck und Zwiebel schneiden.

Der Speck kann ruhig grobwürfelig, die Zwiebel dagegen sollte fein geschnitten werden. Ebenso die verschiedenen Kräuter.

Milch und Mineralwasser werden zu gleichen Teilen in eine Schüssel gegossen. Dann die Eier hineinschlagen und mit dem Schneebesen gleich gleich verrühren. Gestoßener Pfeffer kommt dazu, ebenso wie Salz. Einen Esslöffel Schmalz geben wir nach dem Rezept der Christine auch noch dazu.

Jetzt fehlen noch Zwiebel, die Kräuter und, nicht zu vergessen, der Speck. Zum Schluss noch das Dinkelmehl unterrühren. Dieser Teig wird in einer Schmalz-Butterschmalzmischung herausgebacken.
