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De Facto-itis

My brother the Rev Bob Payne over a period of 12 months has just distributed with the aid of his small Baptist congregation some 50,000 tracts into every letterbox in Frankston Vic. There has been little response to all their hard work, but it is a most consoling thought to know that 120,000 residents in Frankston have been warned of the consequences of dying without Christ and are without excuse.

The project of the tract distribution finished 3 days ago. This very evening a woman rang me from Melbourne telling me that she had been crying and praying for two days at the end of her tether and was contemplating suicide. She walked out to the mail box this afternoon and found one of my brother's little tracts in her letterbox and read it, prayed the prayer that was in it, then rang me to tell me how it changed her life and gave her hope.

This poor woman has had a terrible life of suffering, but the thing that kept her sobbing on the phone and pouring out her heart to me was the extent of the torment she was suffering as the result of the mongrel de facto animal that was living with her daughter and who was continually abusing her grand son.

All de factos are not mongrels or animals, though many of them are, who prey on the kids of their so-called 'partners.' Most de factos are decent, though godless and pagan people. **ALL** de factos are going to hell and there are no exceptions. Many younger de factos live the way they do because both governments have encouraged them to be what they are and they have had no teachings of the wrath of a holy God towards what He calls SIN. They don't even believe that God exists. Are they without excuse? Certainly not! Older de factos have no excuse, they know better. Governments who sponser this vile behaviour are begging God to hand us over to a bunch of foreign butchers who might be able to teach us what it was once like to call out to God for help and deliverance, but by then, it will be too late.

After I had listened to that sobbing woman's tale of woe, a voice seemed to say, "Get the warning you have written titled "The Peril We Face" spread far and wide. My patience with Australia is almost exhausted and the dawning day of my wrath is unavoidable. I am sickened by her fornications, her adulteries and her gross and vile evils. Her days are numbered"

One of greatest sins Australia is committing by far is the sin of fornication. Fornicators leave a message behind to their illegitimate children that there is no God, and that there is no hope. Fornicators and de factos will be directly responsible for the total disintegration of our society and will leave behind them a trail of miserable, dysfunctional, mentally ill, suicidal, and

violent children that will equate in comparison and ratio of social destruction to the Chinese earthquakes, the American twisters, and the Asian tsunamis. Oh yes, you can take it to the bank, we have a price to pay for our behaviour and you can forget about the Great Southland of the Holy Spirit, the Great wide brown land, and the great Aussie land down under.

God warns us in Gal. 5:19-21, “Now the works of the flesh are manifest which are these: Adultery, fornication, uncleanness, lewdness, idolatry, withcraft, hatred, strife, jealousy, wrath, strife, seditions, envyings, murders, drunkenness, revellings and such like, of the which I tell you before as I have told you in times past, that they which do such things, will not inherit the kingdom of God.”

I'm a single mum and before I became a Christian I didn't think there was anything wrong with having a child out of wedlock.

But after I became a Christian and I learnt what God says will happen to children born out of wedlock it really opened my eyes and made me pray (intercede) on behalf of my son that his life would not be affected by the consequences of my actions.

In the Bible, God made marriage as a sacred covenant between man and woman and after marriage that they should have children.

The reason that God ordered that marriage come first- and then sex, and then children, is that when a man and woman are united in a sacred covenant (agreement) before God, they are united as one flesh, and as one flesh and with God's blessing, a protective hedge is established around the couple. When the couple then have children, they are protected by the union of the parents- they have a spiritual 'covering' over them because of the union between man and woman through marriage.

When a child is born out of wedlock, there is no spiritual covering- this leaves the child- and the family- vulnerable to spiritual attacks. Things like sexual immorality, poverty, violence, and addictions are all forms of spiritual attack that lead to destruction- and it is easy to see in our own society, with traditional family values being dismissed, how these forms of destruction are becoming more and more prevalent.

If we look at the people effected by these things we find that usually it is the single parent household who has been caught up. Whether it is intentional to live in a defacto relationship- or from an unplanned pregnancy- children who are born out of wedlock are more likely to end up in problematic lifestyles later on. They are more at risk of being physically abused (usually by a step parent), sexually abused, lured into drug addiction, crime and prison. Studies have shown the majority of prison inmates in America were born out of wedlock.

Even without the Bible, a home with a married mother and father has a more stable, safe environment for the child to be reared in. But understanding the Biblical grounds for marriage and child rearing points out the reality of what happens when we dismiss God's order and go our own way- we can see it in our society today.

Fortunately, once we have repented of our sins and recieved Christ as Lord and Savior, we can also seek the Lord's plans for our children and our own lives- His grace and wisdom is strong enough to combat the spiritual attacks our children may face because they were born out of wedlock. And in Christ, a parent has the authority to cut any curses or attacks that may effect the child.

This is a long topic and I could go on for ages. One thing I have learnt and seen for myself, is that illegitimacy is a curse that runs in families- and usually when it is in one's heritage, then you will also find addictions, violence, poverty etc. Society can deny these things and blame other factors, but the reality is staring us in the face.

I think you've misunderstood my writing.

My views are based on some awesome teaching I received from an organization called Family Foundations. This is the website <http://www.familyfi.org/>

If you would like to know the Biblical foundation for the things I talked about in my piece, this would be the people to contact. I completed a very powerful weekend seminar they did called "Ancient Paths" and this is where I learnt not only the Biblical principles behind marriage and the covering it provides children, but also learnt the spiritual vulnerabilities of children born out of wedlock face.

Family Foundations would have the scriptures to refer you to. I have it all in my notes that I took on the weekend but it would take me some time to locate the exact scriptures that explain about the protective hedge created around a man and woman when they are married- and how when a child is born out of wedlock there is no protective hedge around that child and this leaves them vulnerable to all sorts of spiritual attack.

They also did a very powerful presentations of two family trees from real life examples- both started with a man and a woman- but one couple was married and the other was defacto. They showed how over 3 or 4 generations the defacto couple's lineage created many problems with addictions, crime, poverty etc. On the married side, the children were all doctors, lawyers, teachers etc. It was a powerful presentation.

It no way did the people running the seminar condemn children born out of wedlock- and I think if you read over my writing you will see I didn't condemn children out of wedlock either - but if you take a look around at our society, you will see that it's the kids born out of wedlock who are most vulnerable to addictions, violence, crime, sexual abuse, and mental illness. My previous piece shared the Biblical teachings behind that, so I won't go into it again.

I am a single mother with a beautiful 4 year old son. It was his arrival into my life that lead me to becoming a Christian and lead me to that seminar – it was only after learning about the spiritual consequences for the sin I had committed by having sex outside of marriage that lead to my sons conception- that I was then able to REPENT- and after REPENTING- the Lord showed me how to pray/intercede for my son in order to override the curses he was facing because of my sin. It's a very big thing to get your head around- but the teaching is Biblical and sound and has lead to a powerful healing in my life and also my son's life. And I am grateful that the Lord sent me these teachings early in my son's life so that we won't have to face the struggles others have faced because they did not know how to intercede on behalf of their children.

So in response to your statement that the Lord is all forgiving and the Lord is love- this is true- but the Lord only forgives when we repent.

If we do not repent of our sins then we are facing God's judgment and wrath.

I'm not sure if you've come across that part of the Bible yet. Our friend Ken who writes this website is very fond of pointing out God's judgment and I'm sure he'll be able to refer you to the scriptures relating to sin, death and

judgment. God forgives when we repent- and our forgiveness is made possible only through the death of Jesus Christ on the cross. If one does not repent and accept Christ as their saviour, then they can't be forgiven.

So unfortunately, unless we repent and receive God's forgiveness, the consequences of our actions can then be past onto our children. And if one is ignorant of God's word and teachings about certain issues- then true repentance can't take place- and then we can leave our children and our families to all sorts of spiritual attack and vulnerabilities.

I've also had struggles with mental illness and in the past have advocated for the rights of those who are mentally ill through writing and artwork. Some of my writing are still available online and I've had articles in the newspaper and art shows relating to Mental Illness.

My compassion is with you and your family after all you have gone through- and I am very happy that your granddaughter is so well rounded.

You might want to contact Family Foundations just to have a clearer understanding of the Biblical teachings behind marriage. It's great to have both a mum and dad- God created marriage as a sacred covenant- and the spiritual implications of what that means is worth understanding.

God Bless you my friend and if you ever want to write me personally, please feel free to email me. I've also written booklets on What the Bible says about Mental Illness, family curses etc- it is all based on the Bible- I wouldn't dare put just any old view down in writing without backing it up with scripture.
