### Ken's Favourite Song

As you listen to these melodies, sit back and totally relax for a few minutes and ask your self, "If I died tonight do I know exactly where I am going," and "does that Old Rugged Cross mean as much to me and the situation I am in, as what it needs to?"

**A note to those who might not understand how to down load:** To download successfully, click on the man's face. The site will come up but will stop and start, driving you crazy. On the bottom left hand corner you will see an arrow that stops the site and two verticle bars that start the site again . This will go on and on until you click on the two verticle bars at which time the sound will stop but you will notice the line beginning to move to the right downloading. When the line gets to about half way across the page, click on the arrow and you will hear the song without interruption.
