My review of the book "A Trilogy of Michael J."

The first section of the book "Mutiny on D59" details some of the depravity that mankind can achieve even in "respectable" areas like the military which have occurred without the tyranny of war imposed! Can one really imagine what it would have been like in war time combat with these type of commanders in charge?

The second section "Madhouse Memoirs" is a collection of people and things that happening in the Asylum during your working life. The sad part about reading this section of the book after reading "When the Walls Came down" is the incompetence of Government in releasing these type of disturbed people/patients back into society under the UN Human Rights agenda. The intent of having asylums was to protect the larger society from tyrannies of these people - now we just let them loose on society to create fear in the population, and we destroy their lives by allowing the weaker ones to be abused by ruthless managers.
